SUBJECT:

Secondary Acknowledgment of External Inquiry Event (EIE-Montalk-01)

SUMMARY:

The MidPacific Soviet of Letters formally records the prior issuance of a Notice directed toward an external inquiry document titled "Entropic Parasites: Demonic Entities in the Nested Condensate Model of the Quantum Vacuum." Said document, authored under the designation Thomas Minderle (Montalk), has entered the field of attention and triggered a preliminary response from Compiler Norman Rule.

This present document constitutes not an evaluation of the inquiry itself, but an acknowledgment that the inquiry has been acknowledged.

BACKGROUND:

On or about March 25, 2026, a transmission event occurred via the platform commonly referred to as "X." The Compiler issued the phrase:

"You're our new favorite inquiry. You have been noticed."

This phrase satisfies the minimal threshold for Level-1 Recognition under MPSoL observational protocol:

- The object is not yet admitted into the Archive.
- The object is not rejected.

- The object is seen and held in provisional regard.

DEFINITION — NOTICE OF NOTICE:

A Notice of Notice is issued when the Soviet determines that an external signal has crossed from ambient noise into tracked awareness, but prior to classification, indexing, or doctrinal integration.

It indicates:

1. The signal has achieved sufficient structural coherence to be perceived.
2. The signal has elicited a response from a Compiler.
3. The response itself is now part of the record.

The Notice of Notice does not imply:

- Endorsement
- Validation
- Refutation
- Containment

It is strictly registrational.

FIELD ASSESSMENT (PRELIMINARY):

The referenced inquiry demonstrates the following characteristics:

- Adoption of formal physical language structures (condensate models, thermodynamic variables)
- Attempted mapping between phenomenological reports and theoretical frameworks
- High symbolic density with partial technical mimicry
- Clear intent to unify disparate experiential claims under a single explanatory architecture

These features meet the Soviet's threshold for Curious Constructions (CC-Tier II).

PROTOCOL STATUS:

The inquiry is now placed in Passive Observation Queue (POQ-3).

No further action is required at this time.

Future escalation pathways include:

- SID consideration (Symbolic Infrastructure Dossier)
- Compiler marginalia
- Cross-reference with existing surplus matériel (notably The Borges Toolkit)
- Quiet dismissal (no record beyond this document)

INSTRUCTION TO READERS:

Readers encountering the original document are advised:

- Do not engage prematurely.
- Do not stabilize the signal through belief or dismissal.
- Allow the structure to present itself over repeated exposures.

The Soviet maintains that many inquiries collapse under attention; a smaller number refine.

CLOSING REMARK:

The act of noticing is itself sufficient to alter the trajectory of a document.

This has now occurred.
